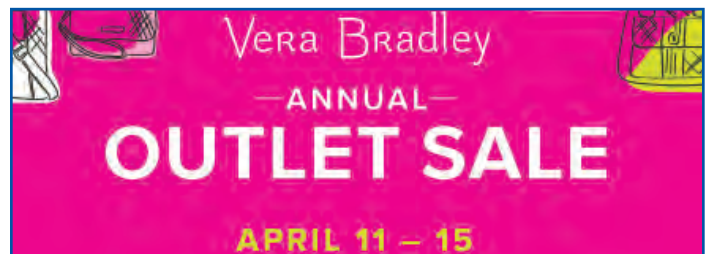

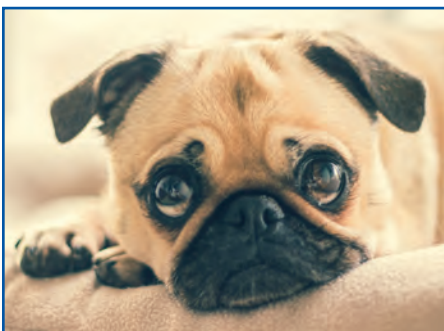

Komets Hockey Ready for Next Season

The Komets are preparing for the upcoming 2018-19 season which will be the 67th season of Komet hockey in Fort Wayne.

Last year, after a successful regular season slate, the Komets qualified for their fifth appearance in the ECHL Kelly Cup playoffs.

The puck drops on the 2018-19 season in October with 72 games on the docket. The Komets will skate 36 home games at the Coliseum and several star players from 2017-18 are expected to return.

The Komets will continue presenting the traditional holiday games on Thanksgiving and New Year's Eve. Arch rivals such as the Indy Fuel, Kalamazoo Wings, Toledo Walleye, Cincinnati Cyclones, and more are expected to return for another season of fast paced, hard-hitting ECHL hockey. 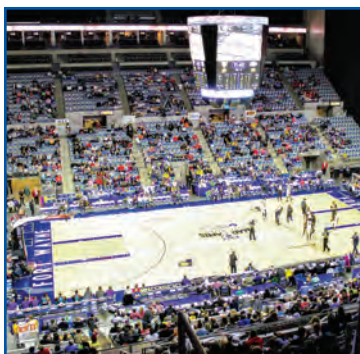
disAbilities Expo

Mad Ants Looking for More Success in 2019



The Fort Wayne Mad Ants continued sustained success on and off the court during the 2017-18 season.

Walt Lemon Jr. and Trey McKinney Jones both earned promotions to the NBA. Lemon earned two separate 10-day contracts from the New Orleans Pelicans, while McKinney Jones signed a 10-day deal with the Indiana Pacers. Walt Lemon Jr. saw action in three games during his first contract – scoring in two appearances against the Phoenix Suns and San Antonio Spurs – which eventually led to another contract with the western conference playoff contender.

Before Walt Lemon Jr. earned his call-up, he and DeQuan Jones both brought home NBA G League Player of the Month honors in November and February respectively. Jones averaged 26.5 points, 5.8 rebounds and shot 59.7 percent in 34.5 minutes per contest through eight games in February. He

also won the 2018 NBA G League Slam Dunk contest on Feb. 18 in Los Angeles as part of the NBA All-Star weekend. Lemon Jr. averaged 26.6 points, 4.7 rebounds, 6.4 assists and 2.7 steals in 41.5 minutes per contest through the first nine games of the 2017-18 season.

The strong bond between the Pacers and Mad Ants only grew in a positive direction throughout the 2017-18 season. Ike Anigbogu, 2017 first round selection TJ Leaf, Alex Poythress and 2017 NBA Slam Dunk champion Glenn Robinson III all suited up in front of the Allen County War Memorial Coliseum crowd with the Mad Ants.

The 'Dons hosted Central Michigan at the Coliseum in front of a national television audience on CBS Sports Network. While Fort Wayne fell to the Chippewas, it was the conclusion of a record breaking season for the 'Dons. Fort Wayne native Bryson Scott finished with a single-season program record 746 points. Scott and John Konchar were named to the All-Summit League First Team.
